What is the Speech and Language program?

The Speech and Language Program works with students who have communication problems that affect success in classroom activities, social interactions, literacy and/or learning.

The program and curriculum at a glance: Students work in small groups or in individual therapy on personalized goals in the areas of:

- ❖ Speech sound production
- ❖ Voice disorders
- ❖ Speaking fluency (stuttering)
- ❖ Social Skills
- ❖ Phonemic awareness
- ❖ Focus, attention, memory, organization
- ❖ Language (i.e., vocabulary, grammar, listening comprehension, pragmatics...)

Placement:

- ❖ Any student may be referred by teacher or parent for a communication screening. If indicated by screening scores, diagnostic evaluation is then completed. Written reports are generated at each step and an individualized goal plan with classroom accommodations is generated, if indicated.
- ❖ Testing is waived for students who enter MQHR with a goal plan in place.

Additionally, our Speech/Language Pathologist coordinates our annual Everybody Counts disabilities awareness program. She also administers our Hearing Conservation program (hearing screening, re-checks, referrals, classroom amplification issues). Our SLP provides critical testing data to outside sources when one of our students is referred for special testing.
