For the 2016-2017 school year, we are using FACTS for both tuition and general accounts payments. You must register for FACTS online. Tuition Payment Options:

Option #1: You can pay in full by June 10, 2016 and receive a 2% discount off your tuition.

Option #2: You can set up a monthly payment schedule via your FACTS account.

Tuition Payment Procedure:

- 1) Tuition is due on the 1st of each month. Payments begin on June 1st for the 2016-2017 school year. The account must be current to reserve a place for your child/ren when school begins in August.
- 2) If payment is not received by the 10th of the month, a \$20 late fee is charged.
- 3) Activity, Snack and Materials Fee are due paid in full by July 15, 2016.
- 4) Tuition delinquency in excess of 30 days may result in removal from the PreK program.
- 5) No student will be reregistered or readmitted for a new school year if tuition, fees for the past school year remain delinquent.
- 6) A Stewardship Family is a registered, active member of Mary, Queen of the Holy Rosary parish. One way this is determined is by the completion of the annual stewardship of Time, Talent and Treasure form.

Mary Queen Parish does not provide tuition assistance to students in the Preschool Program.

Child Care Assistance: Mary Queen Preschool and Afterschool Care program now accepts Child Care Assistance Program funds and GSA subsidy for military and federal families.
