Serving Children in Foster Care in our Counties

Bishop John Stowe held a diocesan meeting in October and asked our schools and churches to find a way to support the influx of hundreds of children into the foster care system in Kentucky. Often, the result of the opioid abuse problem is that the children are moved into foster care and too often arrive with simply a grocery bag with a few belongings. Our plan is to collect and donate the following items to the county foster care agency where your school is located.
