Dear Mary Queen School Families,

Tuition for the 2018-2019 school year has been set and the new tuition rate is included with this letter. The parish finance council, in collaboration with the school finance council and school council has approved a 3% increase in tuition. The increase in tuition addresses the rising costs for salaries and benefits for our faculty and staff and the rise in other fixed expenses. Tuition and fees cover approximately 60% of school expenses, with the remainder of the total cost is covered through parish subsidy and fundraising. We will continue to strive to keep increases to a minimum through diligent financial stewardship and control of expenses. The administration, faculty and staff are committed to providing quality Catholic education for all our students.

The Stewardship rate is available to our Mary Queen parish families. Mary Queen does offer tuition assistance to registered parishioners through the FACTS Grant and Aid <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3WDKM> and there are opportunities for scholarships through our Cornelia Nash Foundation for Catholic Education <http://www.maryqueenschool.org/cornelia-nash-fund>. Another way to help offset your costs is to pay your 2018-2019 tuition in full by July 1, 2018 to receive a 2% discount. The best way to help our school is to refer a family. If you refer a family and they register, then in September, you receive a \$250 tuition credit! Refer more than one family and the savings are endless!

Thank you for the sacrifice and commitment for our school. Your dedication and involvement in the life of the school and the parish contributes to making Mary Queen of the Holy Rosary School not only a nationally recognized Blue Ribbon School of Excellence, but also an excellent example of Catholic Education. Our faculty and staff are dedicated to educating all our students in religious, academic, artistic and social areas and strive to provide all students with the tools necessary to become successful, responsible, contributing, loving members of our church community and society.
