Dear Mary Queen School Families,

Tuition for the 2022-2023 school year has been set and the new tuition rate is included with this letter. Father Dan, in collaboration with the parish finance council, the school finance council and school council has approved a 6% increase in tuition. The increase in tuition addresses the rising costs for salaries and benefits for our faculty and staff and the rise in other fixed expenses. When determining tuition, we try to keep a balance between affordability for our families and the strategic needs of the school with consideration to a zero deficit budget. We encourage our families to keep in mind that the actual cost to educate a student is greater than paid tuition; tuition and fees cover approximately 60% of school expenses, with the remainder of the total cost being covered through parish subsidy and fundraising. We will continue to strive to keep increases to a minimum through diligent financial stewardship and control of expenses. The administration, faculty and staff are committed to providing quality Catholic education for all our students.

The Stewardship rate is available to our active Mary Queen parish families. Mary Queen does offer tuition assistance to registered parishioners through the FACTS Grant and Aid <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3WDKM> and there are opportunities for scholarships through our [Mary Queen School Scholarship Endowment Fund](#). Another way to help offset your costs is to pay your 2022-2023 tuition in full by July 1, 2022 to receive a 2% discount. The best way to help our school is to refer a family. If you refer a family and they register, then in September, you receive a \$250 tuition credit! Refer more than one family and the savings are endless!
